Promoters Conditions

Affiliated to ASA London Region

ASA Licence No 3LR3002

1. The competition will be swum under ASA laws and Fina Technical Rules of Swimming.
2. Over the top starts may be used at the promoter's discretion.
3. The pool is 25m long, 6 lanes, anti wave lane ropes and electronic timing, with ample spectator seating. Car parking is available close by at a charge for the Saturday.
4. Age groups are: 9, 10&11, 12&13, 14+. Awards will be given to the top 6 in each age group. **Age is at midnight on the last day of the competition 6th January 2013**
5. All events will be run on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis. The last heat in each event will be spearheaded. **25m entry times should be submitted.**
6. The entry fees are £4.50 for 50m-200m events and £5.00 for 400m events. Entry fees will be forfeited for withdrawals after confirmation lists have been sent/mailed. **IN THE EVENT OF THE EVENT BEING OVER SUBSCRIBED, REJECTIONS WILL BE MADE BY INDIVIDUAL AGE GROUP AND NOT JOINT AGE GROUP. FOR EXAMPLE, IF 20 SWIMMERS NEED TO BE REJECTED IN THE 10-11 AGE GROUP, 10 SWIMMERS FROM EACH AGE GROUP WILL BE MADE. This applies to the 14+ age group.**
7. Expenses will be paid to Officials who require them. Parking expenses for Officials will be refunded. Regrettably this concession cannot be transferred. Refunds and expenses can be claimed from the Promoter who will be in the computer room.
8. The official **closing date is 24th November 2012**. All entries are subject to meeting the qualifying times. Entries may be restricted in order to keep the session times within appropriate time scales – slowest times within each age group will be rejected. Rejections will be split evenly within each age group ie rejections from 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 age groups. Refunds for rejections under this provision will be given to the Head Coach/Team Manager on the weekend of the gala.
9. This meet will operate as a **card less** meet and swimmers must sign themselves/register themselves within registration period. Signing in starts 15mins before each warm up and is open for 30mins. Swimmers who register late will be accepted only at the promoter's discretion.
10. **All entries MUST be submitted electronically and emailed to lbrscmeetadm@googlemail.com (IF YOU ENCOUNTER PROBLEMS WITH ELECTRONIC ENTRIES, PLEASE CONTACT Mitchell Levine at the above email address or call 07930 687270.**
11. One single club cheque, accompanied by the Financial Summary Sheet needs to be sent to; Mitchell Levine, 98_Trelawny Road, Ilford, IG6 2NW, by the official closing date. **Cheques payable to LBRSC**
12. Coaches' passes for visiting teams available in advance for £10.00 per day (£20 for the weekend) which entitled the holder to refreshments between sessions, a program and emailed / posted results.
13. Coaches, Helpers must wear the wrist band provided. Only competing swimmers, coaches, officials and helpers are allowed on poolside
14. Admission will be £5 for a whole day (£2.50 for children & OAP's) and £2.50 for an afternoon only (£1.50 for children & OAP's). Full day programmes will be sold at a cost of £2.
15. Time Trials **may** be available depending on time and availability, and will be charged at £6 per trial.
16. Coaches must monitor the swim down pool. Failure to do this could result in the facility being withdrawn.
17. All meet participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at Fullwell Cross Leisure Centre and follow the instructions of the pool staff.
18. Swimmers must not go up to the balcony without first drying off and putting on footwear and clothing before leaving the poolside. No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside.
19. Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither LBRSC or Fullwell Cross Leisure Centre can accept responsibility for any property that is lost or stolen.
20. In accordance with the recommendations of the ASA child protection policy, any person wishing to use video, zoom or close range photography, including mobile phones that have photographic capabilities should first register their details at the spectator entrance. It is requested that all mobile phones are switched off or turned to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each event.
21. Consent is deemed to have been given, as required of the data protection act, to the holding and distribution as necessary, of personal information on computer, to run the meet.
22. The promoter reserves the right to alter the schedule if circumstances demand and if necessary to restrict entries.
23. The promoter is Paul Golightly.
24. Any question arising for which these conditions do not provide, shall be determined by the promoter in conjunction with the lead referee.
25. A Swim Shop will be in operation during the gala.
26. DE Photos will be in operation during this meet. If you don't want your child to be photographed, please inform the Promoter
